Funds shall be credited to the trust fund as 20 provided in s. 24.132, to be used for the purposes specified 21 in that section. 22 (2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any 23 fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the 24 25 year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of 26 the trust fund. 27 (3) Pursuant to s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State 28 Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, 29 be terminated on July 1, 2007. However, prior to its scheduled 30 termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2). 31
