Section 8. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (6) of section 112.3148, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

112.3148 Reporting and prohibited receipt of gifts by individuals filing full or limited public disclosure of financial interests and by procurement employees.--

(6)(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (5), an entity of the legislative or judicial branch, a department or commission of the executive branch, a water management district created pursuant to s. 373.069, South Florida Regional Transportation Tri-County Commuter Rail Authority, the Technological Research and Development Authority, a county, a municipality, an airport authority, or a school board may give, either directly or indirectly, a gift having a value in excess of \$100 to any reporting individual or procurement employee if a public purpose can be shown for

1 the gift; and a direct-support organization specifically
 2 authorized by law to support a governmental entity may give
 3 such a gift to a reporting individual or procurement employee
 4 who is an officer or employee of such governmental entity.

 7 gift having a value in excess of \$100 from an entity of the
 8 legislative or judicial branch, a department or commission of
 9 the executive branch, a water management district created
