(1) The Legislature intends to transfer 15 16 the Mental Health Program within the Department of Children 17 and Family Services to the Department of Health, and to transfer all children-in-need-of-services programs and 18 19 families-in-need-of-services programs within the Department of Juvenile Justice to the Department of Children and Family 20 21 Services, effective January 1, 2004. 22 (2) The Legislature intends to direct the Office of 23 Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability to 24 evaluate the transfer of the Substance Abuse Program and the 25 Developmental Disabilities Program to the Department of Health; to assess the effect of such transfer on each program, 26 27 the Department of Health, and the remaining programs within 28 the Department of Children and Family Services; and to report 29 its findings to the Legislature by December 31, 2003. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 31 law.
