Section 2. Subsection (4) of section 624.406, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

624.406 Combinations of insuring powers, one insurer.--An insurer which otherwise qualifies therefor may be authorized to transact any one kind or combination of kinds of insurance as defined in part V except:

(4) A health insurer may also transact excess insurance, specific and aggregate, for self-insurers of a plan of health insurance and multiple-employer welfare arrangements and reinsurance for the medical and lost wages benefits provided under a workers' compensation insurance policy.

Section 3. Section 624.603, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

28 624.603 "Health insurance" defined.--"Health insurance,"
29 also known as "disability insurance," is insurance of human
30 beings against bodily injury, disablement, or death by accident
31 or accidental means, or the expense thereof, or against
32 disablement or expense resulting from sickness, and every
33 insurance appertaining thereto. Health insurance does not
34 include workers' compensation coverages, except as provided in
35 s. 624.406(4).
