Section 257.193, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 13 14 257.193 Community Libraries In Caring Grant Program. -- The purpose of the Community Libraries In Caring 15 Grant Program is to assist libraries in rural communities, as 16 17 defined in s. 288.0656(2)(b), to strengthen their collections and services, and to improve literacy and the economic 18 19 viability of the communities. 20 (1) A library may apply for a grant of a maximum of \$10,000. In order to be eligible for a grant, a library must 21 22 show local or other support that includes cash, in-kind contributions, or other forms of assistance. 23 (2) The Division of Library and Information Services 24 25 of the Department of State shall administer the grant program, 26 adopt rules establishing the application procedures and 27 criteria for review and grant awards, and facilitate the 28 exchange of ideas and services to foster the purposes of the 29 grant program. 30 Section 2. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from 31 the General Revenue Fund to the Division of Library and 1
