Section 1. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 343.63, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

343.63 Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority.-

(2) The governing board of the authority shall consist of seven <del>11</del> voting members, and <del>1 nonvoting member</del> as follows:

(a) The <u>chair of the</u> county commissions of <del>Seminole,</del>
Orange, and Osceola Counties shall each <u>serve, ex officio, for</u>
the term of their respective chairs <u>elect a commissioner as that</u>
commission's representative on the board. The commissioner must

full extent of his or her term. The terms of the county commissioners on the governing board of the authority shall be 2 years.

- (b) One member shall be mayor of a municipality within Seminole, Orange, or Osceola County representing the largest municipal contributor and shall serve a term concurrent with the term of the appointing Governor.
- (c)(b) The Governor shall appoint four members to the board pursuant to local government funding as determined by the sum of contributions for the respective local government for 4 years preceding the appointment as follows:
- 1. Three members shall be appointed to serve a term concurrent with the term of the appointing Governor and shall be appointed from the local government making the largest contribution. However, if the sum of the contributions of the remaining local governments, excluding the contributions of the largest local government contributor, are at least 50 percent of the authority's total local funding contribution, one appointment shall be made from the local government making the second largest contribution. The mayor or chair of the county commission representing the respective local governments entitled to a gubernatorial appointment shall provide a list of three nominees to the Governor for each appointment to the board. The Governor shall appoint one member from each list mayors of the cities of Altamonte Springs, Orlando, and Kissimmee, or a member of each city commission designated by each mayor, shall serve a term of 2 years on the board.

2. One member shall be a resident of the remaining county other than the county meeting the qualifications of subparagraph

1. The chair of the remaining county commission of such county shall provide the Governor with a list of three nominees and the Governor shall appoint one member from such list of nominees.

- shall terminate on June 1, 2003, at which time the terms of the members designated pursuant to paragraphs (b) and (c) shall commence. The Governor shall make appointments to the board within 30 days after receipt of the nominations pursuant to paragraph (c), for a term beginning June 1, 2003, or as soon thereafter as practical appoint five members to the board. Two of the members shall be residents of Orange County, one member shall be a resident of Osceola County, and one member shall be a resident of the City of Orlando. All five members shall serve a term of 4 years.
- (d) The Secretary of Transportation shall appoint the district secretary, or his or her designee, for the district within which the area served by the authority is located and this member shall be a nonvoting member.
- (3) A vacancy during a term shall be filled by the respective appointing authority in the same manner as the original appointment and only for the balance of the unexpired term.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
