

HB 0777 2003

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to acute care hospitals; amending s. 408.043, F.S.; providing for certain acute care hospitals in high growth counties to add additional beds, with the approval of the Agency for Health Care Administration; reenacting s. 395.0191, F.S.; incorporating an amendment by cross reference; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (5) is added to section 408.043, Florida Statutes, to read:

408.043 Special provisions.--

(5) SOLE ACUTE CARE HOSPITALS IN HIGH GROWTH

COUNTIES. --Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an acute care hospital licensed under chapter 395 may add up to 180 additional beds without agency review if such hospital is located in a county that has experienced at least a 60-percent growth rate since 1990, was under construction on January 1, 2002, is the sole acute care hospital in the county, and is the only acute care hospital within a 10-mile radius of the hospital.

Section 2. For the purpose of incorporating the amendment to section 408.043, Florida Statutes, in references thereto, subsection (10) of section 395.0191, Florida Statutes, is reenacted to read:

395.0191 Staff membership and clinical privileges.--

(10) Nothing herein shall be construed by the agency as requiring an applicant for a certificate of need to establish proof of discrimination in the granting of or denial of hospital

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HB 0777 staff membership or clinical privileges as a precondition to obtaining such certificate of need under the provisions of s. 408.043.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.

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
