48 (a) Eligible individuals with incomes equal to or less

52 agency requires on these benefits. For all other prescription  
53 drugs received each month, eligible individuals shall receive a  
54 discount of 50 percent.

56 percent but not more than 150 percent of the federal poverty  
57 level shall receive a discount of 50 percent.

58       (c) Eligible individuals with incomes of more than 150

60 level shall receive a discount of 41 percent.

61       (d) Eligible individuals with incomes of more than 175  
62 percent but not more than 200 percent of the federal poverty  
63 level shall receive a discount of 37 percent.
