 A bill to be entitled

An act relating to bankruptcy; prohibiting the sale or disclosure of personal customer information by persons in bankruptcy; authorizing actions for damages; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) A person who files for bankruptcy may not sell or otherwise transfer to another any database that contains personal customer information if the bankrupt person, through contract or a published privacy policy, agreed or stated that personal customer information would not be disclosed.
- (2) A person whose personal customer information is disclosed in violation of this act may file an action for damages against the person who disclosed such information.

 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
