## I. Summary:

This legislation re-creates the Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund, FLAIR #79-2-086, is administered by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 99-88, Laws of Florida.

## II. Present Situation:

Section 210.20, F.S., creates the trust fund, provides for its purpose, and provides for revenues. Funds are distributed to General Revenue, the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, the Municipal Financial Assistance Trust Fund, the Revenue Sharing for Municipalities Trust Fund, the Public Medical Assistance Trust Fund, the Inter-American Center Authority, and the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center. The major source of revenue for the fund is cigarette taxes. According to LAS/PBS data, receipts to this fund for FY 2001-2002 were \$423 million.
