## House Resolution

A resolution expressing solidarity with Israel in its fight against terrorism.

5 WHEREAS, the ongoing threat of terrorism since September 6 11, 2001, has harmed the economies of Florida and the United 7 States, damaging tourism and travel among the states and 8 creating a negative economic atmosphere, hurting business and 9 producing job losses, and

WHEREAS, the ongoing threat of worldwide terrorism at home and abroad has forced local, state, and federal resources in the United States to be diverted from other critical domestic programs for the purpose of enhancing public security, and

WHEREAS, the United States and Israel are now engaged in a common struggle against terrorism and are on the front lines of a conflict thrust upon them against their will, and

WHEREAS, hundreds of innocent Israelis and Palestinians
have died tragically in violence since September 2000, and

WHEREAS, Israel has lost nearly 700 innocent lives, which as a percentage of population is commensurate with America's losing over 30,000 lives in the terrorist attacks on New York and Washington on September 11, 2001, and

WHEREAS, the ongoing violence has hurt the economies of both Israel and the Palestinian territories, damaging tourism in both regions, thereby creating a negative economic atmosphere hurting business and producing job losses, and

WHEREAS, President George W. Bush declared at a joint session of Congress on September 20, 2001, that "from this day forward any nation that continues to harbor or support terrorism will be regarded by the United States as a hostile regime," and
