House Resolution

A resolution recognizing the 100th anniversary of Whitehall, Henry Flagler's grand Beaux Arts home in Palm Beach.

WHEREAS, after focusing the earlier part of his life on one б of the most profitable corporations in history, Henry Flagler 7 built his first luxury hotel, the Hotel Ponce de Leon, in St. 8 Augustine, thus launching the tourism industry in Florida, and 9 eventually erected a series of eight magnificent hotels along 10 the coast of the state, establishing as well cities such as 11 Daytona Beach and the world-famous winter resort, Palm Beach, 12 and 13

WHEREAS, Flagler built the Florida East Coast Railway to connect the east coast from St. Augustine to Miami and continued across miles of ocean with approximately 160 miles of track, aptly named the Overseas Railroad, hopping from key to key between Miami and Key West, and

WHEREAS, in addition to development, Flagler created a two-19 million-acre agricultural industry and gave thousands of acres 20 of land for schools, churches, parks, and cemeteries, and more 21 than a century later, Florida's agricultural and tourism 22 industries remain the two largest segments of the state's 23 economy, while nonprofit endowments based on his fortune 24 generate in excess of \$50 million in charitable and educational 25 benefits each year, and 26

WHEREAS, in 1903, Henry Flagler lavishly celebrated the opening of his Palm Beach home, Whitehall, a grand Beaux Arts structure that is today a National Historic Landmark visited by
