Section 1011.765, Florida Statutes, is amended 10 11 to read: 1011.765 Florida Academic Improvement Trust Fund matching 12 grants. --13 (1)MATCHING GRANTS. -- The Florida Academic Improvement 14 Trust Fund shall be utilized to provide matching grants to the 15 Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind Endowment Fund and to 16 any public school district education foundation that meets the 17 requirements of this section and is recognized by the local 18 school district as its designated K-12 education foundation. 19 The State Board of Education shall adopt rules for the (a) 20 administration, submission, documentation, evaluation, and 21 approval of requests for matching funds and for maintaining 22 accountability for matching funds. 23 Donations, state matching funds, or proceeds from (b) 24 endowments established pursuant to this section shall be used at 25 the discretion of the public school district education 26 foundation or the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind for 27 academic achievement and classroom support within the school 28 district or school, and shall not be expended for the 29 construction of facilities or for the support of interscholastic 30 Page 1 of 4

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athletics. No public school district education foundation or the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind shall accept or purchase facilities for which the state will be asked for operating funds unless the Legislature has granted prior approval for such acquisition.

(2) ALLOCATION OF THE TRUST FUND.--Funds appropriated to
 the Florida Academic Improvement Trust Fund shall be allocated
 by the <u>Consortium of Florida Education Foundations</u> Department of
 Education in the following manner:

For every year in which there is a legislative 40 (a) 41 appropriation to the trust fund, 1 percent an equal amount of the annual appropriation shall be allocated by match to each of τ 42 to be determined by dividing the total legislative appropriation 43 by the number of local education foundations as well as the 44 Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, with any remaining 45 funds distributed by unweighted FTE must be reserved for each 46 public school district education foundation and the Florida 47 School for the Deaf and the Blind Endowment Fund to provide 48 each foundation and the Florida School for the Deaf and the 49 Blind with an opportunity to receive and match appropriated 50 51 funds. Trust funds that remain unmatched by contribution by January 15 on April 1 of any year shall be made available for 52 matching by any public school district education foundation and 53 by the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind which shall 54 have an opportunity to apply for excess trust funds prior to the 55 award of such funds. 56

(b) Matching grants shall be proportionately allocated from the trust fund on the basis of matching each $\frac{1}{4}$ of state funds with $\frac{1}{4}$ of private funds. To be eligible for matching, a minimum of $\frac{22,500}{4,500}$ must be raised from private sources.

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(c) Funds sufficient to provide the match shall be 61 transferred from the state trust fund to the Consortium of 62 Florida Education Foundations public school education foundation 63 or to the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind Endowment 64 Fund upon certification notification that a proportionate amount 65 has been received and deposited by the individual foundation or 66 the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind school into its 67 own trust fund. 68

(d) If the total of the amounts to be distributed in any
quarter pursuant to this subsection exceeds the amount of funds
remaining from specific appropriations made for the
implementation of this section, all grants shall be
proportionately reduced so that the total of matching grants
distributed does not exceed available appropriations.

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(3) GRANT ADMINISTRATION.--

Each public school district education foundation and (a) 76 the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind participating in 77 the Florida Academic Improvement Trust Fund shall separately 78 account for all funds received pursuant to this section, and may 79 establish its own academic improvement trust fund as a 80 depository for the private contributions, state matching funds, 81 and earnings on investments of such funds. State matching funds 82 shall be administered through the Consortium of Florida 83 Education Foundations, with an administrative fee, not to exceed 84 5 percent, transferred to the public school district education 85 foundation or to the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind 86 Endowment Fund upon certification notification that the 87 foundation or school has received and deposited private 88 contributions that meet the criteria for matching as provided in 89 this section. The public school district education foundations 90

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HB 0911 2003 and the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind are 91 responsible for the maintenance, investment, and administration 92 of their academic improvement trust funds. 93 The public school district education foundations and 94 (b) the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind shall be 95 responsible for soliciting and receiving contributions to be 96 deposited and matched with grants for academic achievement 97 within the school district or school. 98 Each public school district education foundation and (C) 99 the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind shall be 100 responsible for proper expenditure of the funds received 101 pursuant to this section. 102 This act shall take effect July 1, 2003. 103 Section 2.
