A bill to be entitled  
 An act relating to prescriptions for medicinal drugs;  
 prohibiting persons from requiring the use of a federally  
 issued prescriber identification number on a prescription  
 when such use is not otherwise required; providing  
 penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to require the use on a prescription of a federally issued registration number that authorizes the prescriber to prescribe controlled substances or scheduled drugs when that use is not otherwise required by federal or state law or rule. Violation of this section constitutes a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in section 775.082 or section 775.083, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
