The Committee on Health Care recommends the following:

Remove the entire bill and insert:

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to prescription labeling and reimbursement; creating s. 456.0392, F.S.; requiring a prescribing practitioner's federal Drug Enforcement Administration number or professional license number on prescriptions for non-controlled substances; prohibiting requiring the submission of the practitioner's federal Drug Enforcement Administration number as a condition for reimbursement or receipt of benefits; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 456.0392, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

456.0392 Prescription labeling and reimbursement.--Any practitioner authorized under Florida law to write a prescription for a non-controlled substance who does not have a federal Drug Enforcement Administration number shall provide on



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29 | the prescription the practitioner's name and professional
30 | license number. No patient or provider prescribing or dispensing
31 | prescription drugs pursuant to Florida law shall be required to
32 | submit the practitioner's federal Drug Enforcement
33 | Administration number as a condition of reimbursement or receipt

35 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
