Amendment (with title amendment)

On line 28, insert:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 466.004, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

466.004 Board of Dentistry.--

(2) To advise the board, it is the intent of the Legislature that councils be appointed as specified in paragraphs (a), (b), and (c). The department shall provide administrative support to the councils and shall provide public notice of meetings and agenda of the councils. Councils shall include at least one board member who shall chair the council and shall include nonboard members. All council members shall be appointed by the board chair. Council members shall be appointed for 4-year terms, and all members shall be eligible for reimbursement of expenses in the manner of board members.

Amendment No. (for drafter's use only)

28 (a) A Council on Dental Hygiene shall be appointed by the
 29 board chair and shall include one dental hygienist member of the
 30 board, who shall chair the council, one dental member of the
 31 board, and three dental hygienists who are actively engaged in
 32 the practice of dental hygiene in this state. The council shall
 33 meet at the request of the board chair, a majority of the
 34 members of the board, or the council chair, provided the council
 35 meets at least twice a year. The council is charged with the
 36 responsibility of and shall meet for the purpose of developing
 37 rules and policies for recommendation to the board, ~~which the~~
 38 ~~board shall consider~~, on matters pertaining to that part of
 39 dentistry consisting of educational, preventive, or therapeutic
 40 dental hygiene services; dental hygiene licensure, discipline,
 41 or regulation; and dental hygiene education. Rule and policy
 42 recommendations of the council shall be considered by the board
 43 at its next regularly scheduled meeting in the same manner it
 44 considers rule and policy recommendations from designated
 45 subcommittees of the board. Any rule or policy proposed by the
 46 board pertaining to the specified part of dentistry defined by
 47 this paragraph shall be referred to the council for a
 48 recommendation prior to final action by the board.
