## I. Summary:

This legislation re-creates the Operating Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Operating Trust Fund, FLAIR #70-2-510, is administered by the Department of Law Enforcement. This fund was created by Chapter 98-365.

## II. Present Situation:

The Operating Trust Fund was created to receive funds generated by court-imposed fees, cost of supervision payments and subsistence payments by inmates in community facilities.

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
