(6) It is the intent of the Legislature to officially recognize the Florida National Scenic Trail as Florida's

official statewide trail from the Florida Panhandle to the

encourage all state, regional, and local agencies who acquire

lands to include in their land-buying efforts the acquisition of sufficient legal interest in the lands over which the trail passes to ensure its continued existence in a permanent location and to give each parcel of land proposed to be purchased which includes a portion of the trail additional priority points for acquisition within their land-buying processes.

- Section 2. Subsection (6) of section 260.0142, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 260.0142 Florida Greenways and Trails Council; composition; powers and duties.--
- (6) A vacancy on the council shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment. Members whose terms have expired may continue to serve until replaced or reappointed. No member shall serve on the council for more than two consecutive terms.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
