Between line(s) 843 and 844, insert:

Section 35. In order to implement Specific Appropriation 59 of the 2003-2004 General Appropriations Act, paragraph (g) of subsection (2) of section 1011.71, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1011.71 District school tax.--

(2) In addition to the maximum millage levy as provided in subsection (1), each school board may levy not more than 2 mills against the taxable value for school purposes to fund:

(g) Payment of costs directly related to complying with state and federal environmental statutes, rules, and regulations governing school facilities and the cost of property and casualty insurance.
