Section 6. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (2) of section 316.006, Florida Statutes, to read:

316.006 Jurisdiction.--Jurisdiction to control traffic is vested as follows:

(2) MUNICIPALITIES.--

(c) Notwithstanding other provisions of law to the contrary, a municipality may, by interlocal agreement with a county, agree to transfer traffic regulatory authority over areas within the municipality to that county.

This subsection shall not limit those counties which have the charter powers to provide and regulate arterial, toll, and other roads, bridges, tunnels, and related facilities from the proper

29 traffic control devices which conform to the manual and
