Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 39, lines 14 through 26, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 9. A new paragraph (h) is added to subsection (4), and paragraph (b) of subsection (3) and paragraphs (a) and (d) of present subsection (6) of section 220.187, Florida Statutes, are amended, present subsections (5), (6), and (7) of that section are redesignated as subsections (6), (7), and (8), respectively, and a new subsection (5) is added to that section, to read:

220.187 Credits for contributions to nonprofit scholarship-funding organizations.--

(3) AUTHORIZATION TO GRANT SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING TAX CREDITS; LIMITATIONS ON INDIVIDUAL AND TOTAL CREDITS.--

(b) The total amount of tax credits and carryforward of tax credits ~~credit~~ which may be granted each state fiscal year under this section is ~~\$88~~\$50 million.

1 SCHOLARSHIP-FUNDING ORGANIZATIONS.--

2 (h) An eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding
3 organization may provide scholarships, not to exceed 10% of
4 the amount of eligible contributions it has received, to
5 dependent children of active duty United States Armed Forces
6 personnel living in the state and to dependent children of
7 those active duty United States Armed Forces personnel who
8 died in Operation Desert Shield, Operation Desert Storm,
9 Operation Enduring Freedom, or Operation Iraqi Freedom if such
10 personnel were residents of the state during the period of
11 that military acton.
