The 22 Department of the Lottery shall transfer moneys to the 23 Educational Enhancement Trust Fund at least once each quarter. 24 Funds in the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund shall be used to 25 the benefit of public education in accordance with the 26 provisions of this act. Such lottery revenues are 34 hereby pledged to the payment of debt service on bonds issued by 35 the state pursuant to s. 1013.68 or s. 1013.70. Debt service 36 payable on bonds issued by the state pursuant to s. 1013.68 or 37 s. 1013.70 shall be payable from the first lottery revenues 38 transferred to the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund in each 39 fiscal year. Amounts distributable to school districts that 40 41 request the issuance of bonds pursuant to s. 1013.68(3) are hereby pledged to such bonds pursuant to s. 11(d), Art. VII of 42 the State Constitution. The amounts distributed through the 43 Classrooms First Program shall equal \$145 million in each fiscal 44 year. These funds are intended to provide up to \$2.5 billion for 45 public school facilities. 46

1010.70 Educational Enhancement Trust Fund.--Each fiscal year, at least <u>39</u> <del>38</del> percent of the gross revenue from the sale of lottery tickets, variable percentages of the gross revenue from the sale of instant lottery tickets, and other earned revenue, excluding application processing fees, shall be deposited in the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund as provided in s. 24.121.

56 Section 3. <u>If any law amended by this act was also amended</u> 57 <u>by a law enacted at the 2003 Regular Session of the Legislature,</u> 58 <u>such laws shall be construed as if they had been enacted at the</u> 59 <u>same session of the Legislature, and full effect shall be given</u> 60 to each if possible.

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Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.

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
