Section 50. In order to implement Specific Appropriations 2889-2897 of the 2003-2004 General Appropriations Act, subsection (2) of section 267.17, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

267.17 Citizen support organizations; use of state administrative services and property; audit.--

- (2) USE OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND PROPERTY. --
- (a) The division may fix and collect charges for the rental of facilities and properties managed by the division and may permit, without charge, appropriate use of <u>administrative</u> <u>services</u>, property, and facilities of the division by a citizen support organization, subject to the provisions of this section. Such use must be directly in keeping with the approved purposes

of the citizen support organization and may not be made at times or places that would unreasonably interfere with opportunities for the general public to use such facilities for established purposes. Any moneys received from rentals of facilities and properties managed by the division may be held in the operating trust fund of the division or in a separate depository account in the name of the citizen support organization and subject to the provisions of the letter of agreement with the division.

- (b) The division may prescribe by rule any condition with which a citizen support organization shall comply in order to use division administrative services, property, or facilities.
- (c) The division shall not permit the use of any administrative services, property, or facilities of the state by a citizen support organization which does not provide equal membership and employment opportunities to all persons regardless of race, color, religion, sex, age, or national origin.

Section 51. The amendment of s. 267.17, Florida Statutes, by this act shall expire on July 1, 2004, and the text of that section shall revert to that in existence on June 30, 2003, except that any amendments to such text enacted other than by this act shall be preserved and continue to operate to the extent that such amendments are not dependent upon the portions of such text which expire pursuant to the provisions of this act.
