A bill to be entitled

An act relating to trust funds; creating s. 550.2632, F.S.; creating the Video Lottery Thoroughbred Trust Fund within the Department of Business and Professional Regulation; providing for source of moneys and purposes; providing for annual carryforward of funds; providing for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing for construction of the act in pari materia with laws enacted during the 2003 Regular Session or the 2003 Special Session A of the Legislature;

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

providing a contingent effective date.

Section 1. Section 550.2632, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

550.2632 Video Lottery Thoroughbred Trust Fund.--

to be administered by the Department of Business and

Professional Regulation. Funds shall be credited to the trust

fund as provided in s. 24.132, and shall be distributed as

The Video Lottery Thoroughbred Trust Fund is created,

provided in s. 24.133, to be used for the purposes specified in that section.

(2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.

(3) Pursuant to s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State

Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be
terminated on July 1, 2007. However, prior to its scheduled



HB 0015B 2003 termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2).

Section 2. If any law amended by this act was also amended by a law enacted at the 2003 Regular Session of the Legislature or at the 2003 Special Session A of the Legislature, such laws shall be construed as if they had been enacted at the same session of the Legislature, and full effect shall be given to each if possible.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, if House Bill 13B or similar legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law.
