Twenty-five percent shall be used to establish and administer advice centers that will provide informative and 32 educational informational materials and referral services to 33 assist recently arrived residents, prospective residents, and 34 individuals in adapting to living, working, and doing business 35 in the State of Florida, particularly to prevent fraudulent 36 conduct. 37 2. Twenty percent shall be distributed as grants, as 38 determined by an internal review committee, to organizations 39 whose efforts are specifically directed toward protecting 40 41 Florida residents from fraudulent business practices, corporate scams, identity theft, and other fraud. 42 3. Ten percent shall be distributed to identified agencies 43 to assist them with efforts that are specifically directed 44 toward providing Florida residents with a toll-free hotline to 45 fight fraud and corporate scams. 46 4. If any law amended by this act was also amended 56 by a law enacted at the 2003 Regular Session of the Legislature 57 or at the 2003 Special Session A of the Legislature, such laws 58 59 shall be construed as if they had been enacted at the same
