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Representative Harper offered the following:

Amendment

Remove line(s) 286-338, and insert:

7. Requiring the grantee to coordinate and comply with the contracting requirements adopted by the Office of Supplier Diversity under s. 287.09451 and with the ordinances, including any small-business ordinances, enacted by the county in which the biomedical research institution and campus are located in this state.

8. Requiring the grantee to work collaboratively with the state's public and private postsecondary educational institutions and not-for-profit research institutions.

9. Requiring the grantee to participate in employee-recruitment activities at a minimum of five public or private universities or community colleges in this state every year during the duration of the contract.

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28 10. Requiring the grantee to use the Internet-based job-
29 listing system of the Agency for Workforce Innovation in
30 advertising employment opportunities.

31 11. Requiring the grantee to establish accredited science
32 degree programs.

33 12. Requiring the grantee to establish internship programs
34 to create learning opportunities for educators and secondary and
35 postsecondary students, including graduate and doctoral
36 students.

37 13. Requiring the grantee to submit data to the
38 corporation on its activities and performance during each fiscal
39 year and to provide to the corporation an annual accounting of
40 the expenditure of funds disbursed under this section.

41 14. Authorizing the grantee, when feasible, to use
42 information submitted by it to the Federal Government or to
43 other organizations awarding research grants to the grantee to
44 help meet reporting requirements imposed under this section or
45 the contract, if the information satisfies the reporting
46 standards of this section and the contract.

47 15. Requiring the grantee during the first 7 years of the
48 contract to create 545 positions and to acquire associated
49 research equipment for the grantee's facility in this state, and
50 pay for related maintenance of the equipment, in a total amount
51 of not less than \$45 million.

52 16. Requiring the grantee to progress in the creation of
53 the total number of jobs prescribed in subparagraph 14. on the
54 following schedule: 38 positions in the first year, 168
55 positions in the second year, 280 positions in the third year,
56 367 positions in the fourth year, 436 positions in the fifth

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57 year, 500 positions in the sixth year, and 545 positions in the
58 seventh year. The board may allow the grantee to deviate from
59 such employee levels by 25 percent in any year, to allow the
60 grantee flexibility in achieving the objectives set forth in the
61 business plan provided to the corporation; however, the grantee
62 must have no fewer than 545 positions by the end of the seventh
63 year.

64 17. Requiring the grantee's expenditure of funds to be
65 consistent with legislative intent as provided in this act.

66 18. Requiring the grantee to allow the corporation to
67 retain an independent national accounting firm to inspect the
68 records of the grantee in order to audit the expenditure of
69 funds disbursed to the grantee. The independent national
70 accounting firm shall not disclose any confidential or
71 proprietary scientific information of the grantee.

72 19. Requiring the grantee to purchase liability insurance
73 and governing the coverage level of such insurance.
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
