This legislation re-creates the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant Trust Fund, FLAIR #52-2-451, is administered by the Department of Community Affairs. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 2000-29, Laws of Florida.

This fund is used to administer the Federal Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program providing home energy assistance benefits to eligible households pursuant to s. 409.508(2), F.S.
