73 funding may come from each county's share of the ninth-cent fuel 74 tax, the local option fuel tax, or any other source of local gas 75 taxes or other nonfederal funds available to the counties. In 76 addition, the Legislature authorizes the levy of an annual 77 license tax in the amount of \$2 for the registration or renewal 78 of registration of each vehicle taxed under s. 320.08 and 79 registered in the area served by the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority. The annual license tax shall take 80 81 effect in any county served by the authority upon approval by the residents in a county served by the authority. The annual 82 83 license tax shall be levied and the Department of Highway Safety 84 and Motor Vehicles shall remit the proceeds each month from the 85 tax to the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority.
