2 An act relating to trust funds; re-creating the
3 Capital Collateral Representative Trust Fund
4 within the Justice Administrative Commission
5 without modification; carrying forward current
6 balances and continuing current sources and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of
10 the Capital Collateral Representative Trust Fund within the
11 Justice Administrative Commission, which is otherwise
12 scheduled to be terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate,
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the trust fund
15 before its scheduled termination date and has found that it
16 continues to meet an important public purpose, and

17 WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public
18 policy concerning the trust fund sets adequate parameters for
19 its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

21 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

22
23 Section 1. (1) The Capital Collateral Representative
24 Trust Fund within the Justice Administrative Commission, FLAIR
25 number 21-2-072, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section
26 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4,
27 2004, is re-created.

28 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried
29 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund
30 are continued.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4,
2 2004.
