5 Section 4. Section 290.00675, Florida Statutes, is amended

7 290.00675 Amendment of certain enterprise zone
8 boundaries.--

9 (1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the
10 Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may amend the
11 boundaries of an area designated as an enterprise zone in a
12 community having a population of 235,000 persons but less than
13 260,000, so long as the area does not increase the overall size
14 of the zone by greater than 25 acres and the increased area is
15 contiguous to the existing enterprise zone. The amendment must

16 also be consistent with the limitations imposed by s. 290.0055
17 upon establishment of the enterprise zone.

18 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Office
19 of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may amend the
20 boundaries of an area designated as The City of
21 Brooksville/Hernando County Enterprise Zone # 2701. Hernando
22 County is a community having a population greater than 140,000.
23 The boundary amendment must not increase the overall size of the
24 enterprise zone by more than 5 square miles. The increased area
25 shall be contiguous to the existing enterprise zone. The
26 boundary amendment must also be consistent with the limitations
27 imposed by s. 290.0055. The application package for the boundary
28 amendment must be submitted to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and
29 Economic Development no later than December 31, 2004.

30 Section 5. Section 290.00704, Florida Statutes, is created
31 to read:

32 290.00704 Enterprise zone designation for the City of Lake
33 Wales.--The City of Lake Wales may apply to the Office of
34 Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for designation of one
35 enterprise zone for an area within the City of Lake Wales, which
36 zone shall encompass an area up to 3 contiguous square miles.
37 The application must be submitted by December 31, 2004, and must
38 comply with the requirements of s. 290.0055. Notwithstanding the
39 provisions of s. 290.0065, limiting the total number of
40 enterprise zones designated and the number of enterprise zones
41 within a population category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and
42 Economic Development may designate one enterprise zone under
43 this section. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic

44 Development shall establish the initial effective date of the
45 enterprise zone designated pursuant to this section.

46 Section 6. (1) Notwithstanding the limitation in section
47 290.0065, Florida Statutes, on the number of enterprise zones
48 within a population category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and
49 Economic Development shall designate, upon joint application by
50 Miami-Dade County and the City of Hialeah, an area within the
51 municipality of the City of Hialeah in an area bounded by 32nd
52 Street, 21st Street, Palm Avenue, and East 4th Avenue as an
53 enterprise zone. The application must be submitted by June 1,
54 2004, and must comply with the requirements of section 290.0055,
55 Florida Statutes, except for paragraph(4)(d). The effective date
56 of the enterprise zone is July 1, 2004.
