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Senator Saunders moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 7, before line 1,

insert:

Section 6. Paragraph (h) is added to subsection (3) of section 400.9905, Florida Statutes, to read:

400.9905 Definitions.--

(3) "Clinic" means an entity at which health care services are provided to individuals and which tenders charges for reimbursement for such services. For purposes of this part, the term does not include and the licensure requirements of this part do not apply to:

(h) Entities that provide oncology or radiation therapy services by physicians licensed under chapter 458.

Section 7. The amendment made by this act to section 400.9905(3), Florida Statutes, is intended to clarify the legislative intent of this provision as it existed at the time the provision initially took effect as section 456.0375(1)(b), Florida Statutes, and section 400.9905(3)(h), Florida

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1 Statutes, as created by this act, shall operate retroactively  
2 to October 1, 2001.
