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Senator Bennett moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 109, between lines 21 and 22,

insert:

Section 34. The Agency for Health Care Administration shall create a Medicaid fraud detection system. The agency shall contract for the purpose of developing this system with a contractor who is capable of linking national public records data with terabytes of existing state data regarding Medicaid program recipients and providers. The agency shall integrate data from the Department of Health regarding provider licensure, agency data regarding Medicaid provider program status, and the Department of Children and Family Services and the Agency for Workforce Innovation regarding recipient eligibility and status. This contractor must have the flexibility to access this high volume of data in 5 seconds or less against a data set of multiple billions of records and must have the ability to provide a globally unique identifier to each medical recipient and provider in order to ensure the

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1 confidentiality of personal information. This identifier must  
 2 not be the individual's social security number, but must be  
 3 based upon any combination of names, addresses, social  
 4 security numbers, and dates of birth. The contractor must have  
 5 experience dealing with, and integrating together, different  
 6 types of public and proprietary data. The contractor must be  
 7 capable of processing unstructured text and must be able to  
 8 complete data integration within 90 days after the execution  
 9 of the contract.
