 2           An act relating to drivers' licenses; amending s. 322.08,  
 3           F.S.; providing for license applicants to make a \$2  
 4           voluntary contribution to the American Cancer Society;  
 5           providing an effective date.

 7   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 9           Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 322.08, Florida  
 10          Statutes, is amended to read:

11           322.08 Application for license.--

12           (6) The application form for a driver's license or  
 13          duplicate thereof shall include language permitting the  
 14          following:

15           (a) A voluntary contribution of \$5 per applicant, which  
 16          contribution shall be transferred into the Election Campaign  
 17          Financing Trust Fund.

18           (b) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
 19          contribution shall be deposited into the Florida Organ and  
 20          Tissue Donor Education and Procurement Trust Fund for organ and  
 21          tissue donor education and for maintaining the organ and tissue  
 22          donor registry.

23           (c) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
 24          contribution shall be distributed to the Florida Council of the  
 25          Blind.

26           (d) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which  
 27          shall be distributed to the Hearing Research Institute,  
 28          Incorporated, for the purpose of infant hearing screening in  
 29          Florida.

30 (e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which  
31 shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation  
32 International.

33 (f) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which  
34 shall be distributed to the American Cancer Society,  
35 notwithstanding s. 322.081.

37 A statement providing an explanation of the purpose of the trust  
38 funds shall also be included.

39 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
