24	(b) A mammogram every 2 years for any woman who is 40
25	years of age or older, but younger than 50 years of age, or
26	more frequently based on the patient's physician's
27	recommendation.
28	(c) A mammogram every year for any woman who is 50
29	years of age or older.
30	(d) One or more mammograms a year, based upon a

31 physician's recommendation, for any woman who is at risk for

breast cancer because of a personal or family history of breast cancer, because of having a history of biopsy-proven benign breast disease, because of having a mother, sister, or daughter who has or has had breast cancer, or because a woman has not given birth before the age of 30.

It is the intent of the Legislature that, when practice parameters for the delivery of mammography services are developed pursuant to s. 408.02(7), the Legislature review the requirements of this section and conform to the practice parameters.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 627.6613, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

627.6613 Coverage for mammograms.--

- (1) A group, blanket, or franchise accident or health insurance policy issued, amended, delivered, or renewed in this state must provide coverage for at least the following:
- (a) A baseline mammogram for any woman who is 35 years of age or older, but younger than 40 years of age.
- (b) A mammogram every 2 years for any woman who is 40 years of age or older, but younger than 50 years of age, or more frequently based on the patient's physician's recommendation.
- (c) A mammogram every year for any woman who is 50 years of age or older.
- (d) One or more mammograms a year, based upon a physician's recommendation, for any woman who is at risk for breast cancer because of a personal or family history of breast cancer, because of having a history of biopsy-proven benign breast disease, because of having a mother, sister, or
