16	delivery of services and the ability of the community to	
17	interact with the school district. Additionally, the committee	
18	shall evaluate, but not be limited to, the following: the numbe	<u>er</u>
19	of district school board members; single-member representation	;
20	district school board member term limits; campaign finance	
21	relating to election of district school board members; the	
22	position of district school superintendent; the school	
23	district's administrative organizational structure; the creation	on
24	of a construction and facilities board comprised of citizens in	n
25	the community to monitor land purchase and construction of	
26	educational facilities; and the division of the school district	t

45	(4) Based on its review, the committee shall report to the
46	district school board recommended changes to the governing
47	structure of the school district no later than July 1, 2005.
