
#### Abstract

A bill to be entitled An act relating to school district governance; requiring the creation of a committee in specified school districts to review the current governing structure of the school district; specifying the areas to be evaluated; providing committee membership and staff; providing for committee recommendations; providing an effective date.


Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) A committee shall be established in each school district with a $\mathrm{K}-12$ student enrollment in excess of 250,000 students to review the current governing structure of the school district. The emphasis of the committee's review shall be an evaluation of the school district's performance in delivery of services and the ability of the community to interact with the school district. Additionally, the committee shall evaluate, but not be limited to, the following: the number of district school board members; single-member representation; district school board member term limits; campaign finance relating to election of district school board members; the position of district school superintendent; the school district's administrative organizational structure; the creation of a construction and facilities board comprised of citizens in the community to monitor land purchase and construction of educational facilities; and the division of the school district into smaller school districts.
(2) The committee shall have the following membership:
(a) Two members appointed by the Governor.

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(b) One member of the State Board of Education.
(c) One member appointed by the President of the Senate.
(d) One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of

Representatives.
(e) One district school board member of the school district being evaluated.
(f) The district school superintendent of the school district being evaluated.
(g) An attorney from the Office of the Attorney General.
(h) The mayors of the two municipalities in the school district with the largest population.
(3) The committee shall have a staff consisting of a fulltime executive secretary, a contracted attorney, and a contracted specialized consultant to assist in the school district review.
(4) Based on its review, the committee shall report to the district school board recommended changes to the governing structure of the school district no later than July 1, 2005.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.

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
