An act relating to school personnel; creating
s. 1012.47, F.S.; requiring certain personnel
in an alternative school that operates under
contract with a district school system to file
a set of fingerprints; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1012.47, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

1012.47 Employment of alternative school
personnel.--All instructional and noninstructional personnel
who are hired to fill positions requiring direct contact with
students in an alternative school that operates under contract
with a district school system must, upon employment and
according to conditions of the contract, file a complete set
of fingerprints as required in s. 1012.32.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
