Statistical abstracts of 25 information collected by the board or the office may be 26 27 released or published, but only in a manner that does not 28 identify or allow identification of subscribers or their 29 service numbers or of revenues attributable to any provider. (2) As used in this section, the term "proprietary 30

confidential business information" means customer lists,

customer numbers, and other related information, technology descriptions, technical information, or trade secrets, including trade secrets as defined in s. 812.081, and the actual or developmental costs of E911 systems that are developed, produced, or received internally by a provider or by a provider's employees, directors, officers, or agents. (3) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 1, 2004, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2004. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* SENATE SUMMARY Removes the repeal of an exemption from the public records law for proprietary business information held by the Wireless 911 Board or the State Technology Office and which is scheduled to occur on October 1, 2004, under the Open Government Sunset Review Act.
