A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to service charges; amending  
ss. 319.32 and 320.04, F.S.; increasing certain  
service charges for certificates of title and  
license plates, certain stickers, or  
registration certificates; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section  
319.32, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

319.32 Fees; service charges; disposition.--

(2)(a) There shall be a service charge of \$7~~\$4.25~~ for  
each application which is handled in connection with the  
issuance, duplication, or transfer of any certificate of  
title. There shall be a service charge of \$1.25 for each  
application which is handled in connection with the  
recordation or notation of a lien on a motor vehicle or mobile  
home which is not in connection with the purchase of such  
vehicle.

Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section  
320.04, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

320.04 Registration service charge.--

(1)(a) There shall be a service charge of \$3~~\$2.50~~ for  
each application which is handled in connection with original  
issuance, duplicate issuance, or transfer of any license  
plate, mobile home sticker, or validation sticker or with  
transfer or duplicate issuance of any registration  
certificate. There may also be a service charge of up to \$1  
for the issuance of each license plate validation sticker,

1 vessel decal, and mobile home sticker issued from an automated  
2 vending facility or printer dispenser machine which shall be  
3 payable to and retained by the department to provide for  
4 automated vending facilities or printer dispenser machines  
5 used to dispense such stickers and decals by each tax  
6 collector's or license tag agent's employee.

7 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.

12 This CS deletes a provision that provided for adjustment of  
13 title and registration transaction service charges every three  
14 years by rule of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor
