Section 316.1935, Florida Statutes, is 11 amended to read: 12 316.1935 Fleeing or attempting to elude a law 13 enforcement officer; aggravated fleeing or and eluding .--(1) It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle, 14 having knowledge that he or she has been ordered to stop such 15 vehicle by a duly authorized law enforcement officer, 16 17 willfully to refuse or fail to stop the vehicle in compliance 18 with such order or, having stopped in knowing compliance with 19 such order, willfully to flee in an attempt to elude the 20 officer, and a person who violates this subsection commits a felony misdemeanor of the third first degree, punishable as 21 provided in s. 775.082, or s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. 22 (2) Any person who willfully flees or attempts to 23 24 elude a law enforcement officer in an authorized law 25 enforcement patrol vehicle, with or without agency insignia and other jurisdictional markings prominently displayed on the 26 27 vehicle, with siren and lights activated commits a felony of 28 the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 29 775.083, or s. 775.084. It is an affirmative defense to a

prosecution under this subsection that a person, having been

- (3) Any person who willfully flees or attempts to elude a law enforcement officer in an authorized law enforcement patrol vehicle, with or without agency insignia and other jurisdictional markings prominently displayed on the vehicle, with siren and lights activated, and during the course of the fleeing or attempted eluding:
- (a) Drives at high speed, or in any manner which demonstrates a wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property, commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
- (b) Drives at high speed, or in any manner which demonstrates a wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property, and causes serious bodily injury or death to another person, including any law enforcement officer involved in pursuing or otherwise attempting to effect a stop of the person's vehicle, commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the court shall sentence any person convicted of committing the offense described in this paragraph to a mandatory minimum sentence of 3 years' imprisonment. Nothing in this paragraph shall prevent a court from imposing a greater sentence of incarceration as authorized by law.
- (4) Any person who, in the course of unlawfully leaving or attempting to leave the scene of a crash in

- (5) The court <u>shall</u> <u>may</u> revoke, for a period not <u>less</u> than to exceed 1 year <u>nor exceeding 5 years</u>, the driver's license of any operator of a motor vehicle convicted of a violation of subsection (1), subsection (2), subsection (3), or subsection (4).
- (6) Notwithstanding s. 948.01, no court may suspend, defer, or withhold adjudication of guilt or imposition of sentence for any violation of this section. A person convicted and sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of incarceration under paragraph (3)(b) or paragraph (4)(b) is not eligible for statutory gain-time under s. 944.275 or any form of discretionary early release, other than pardon or executive clemency or conditional medical release under s. 947.149, prior to serving the mandatory minimum sentence.
- (7) Any motor vehicle involved in a violation of this section is deemed to be contraband, which may be seized by a law enforcement agency and is subject to forfeiture pursuant to ss. 932.701-932.704. Any vehicle not required to be titled under the laws of this state is presumed to be the property of the person in possession of the vehicle.

- (1) A person who, within a 3-year period, is convicted of two of the following serious traffic violations or any combination thereof, arising in separate incidents committed in a commercial motor vehicle shall, in addition to any other applicable penalties, be disqualified from operating a commercial motor vehicle for a period of 60 days:
- (a) A violation of any state or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control, other than a parking violation, a weight violation, or a vehicle equipment violation, arising in connection with a crash resulting in death or personal injury to any person;
 - (b) Reckless driving, as defined in s. 316.192;
 - (c) Careless driving, as defined in s. 316.1925;
- Fleeing or attempting to elude a law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 316.1935;
- (e) Unlawful speed of 15 miles per hour or more above the posted speed limit;
- Driving a commercial motor vehicle, owned by such person, which is not properly insured;
 - Improper lane change, as defined in s. 316.085; or (q)
 - Following too closely, as defined in s. 316.0895. (h)
- Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004, 31 and shall apply to offenses committed on or after that date.
