A bill to be entitled
An act relating to rules of criminal procedure;
repealing Rule 3.380, Florida Rules of Criminal
Procedure, relating to motions for judgment of
acquittal; providing a contingent effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Rule 3.380, Florida Rules of Criminal
Procedure, is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004, if
enacted by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the membership
of each house of the Legislature.

SENATE SUMMARY

Repeals Rule 3.380, Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure,
which provides for consideration of a motion for judgment
of acquittal at the close of the state's evidence or at
the close of all evidence in the case.
