A bill to be entitled

An act relating to Escambia County; repealing chapter 24500 (1947), Laws of Florida, as amended; abolishing the Santa Rosa Island Authority and transferring all powers, duties, assets, and liabilities of the authority to the Santa Rosa Island Authority, a Charter Agency, created by the Charter for Escambia County; providing for employees of the authority to become employees of the Charter Agency; providing for referendum approval; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Chapter 24500 (1947), Laws of Florida, as amended by chapters 25810 (1949), 26422 (1949), 61-2797, 63-1322, 70-680, 75-366, 76-361, 76-362, 76-368, 76-371, 79-457, 83-407, 84-426, and 85-409, Laws of Florida, is repealed.

Section 2. On the effective date of this act, all powers, duties, assets, and liabilities of the Santa Rosa Island Authority are transferred to the Santa Rosa Island Authority, a Charter Agency, created by the Charter for Escambia County approved by a majority of the voters of Escambia County in a referendum election on March 9, 2004. On the effective date of this act, employees of the Santa Rosa Island Authority shall become employees of the Charter Agency.

Section 3. This act shall take effect November 15, 2004, if the Charter for Escambia County is approved by a majority of the voters of Escambia County in a referendum election on March 9, 2004.
