An act relating to installations honoring military veterans and their families; creating the "Ellwood Robinson 'Bob' Pipping, Jr., Memorial Act"; providing a popular name; providing purpose; authorizing the Department of Transportation to enter into contract with a group or organization for the installation and maintenance of plaques, markers, monuments, memorials, or various retired military equipment at rest stops; providing for a committee to approve proposals for the contracts; providing for membership and terms of members of the committee; requiring approval by said committee for such contracts; providing conditions for approval; providing that the group or organization shall be responsible for costs; requiring that the group or organization provide a bond to secure certain costs; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

HB 1383 2004 **CS**

Section 1. This act shall be known by the popular name the "Ellwood Robinson 'Bob' Pipping, Jr., Memorial Act."

Section 2. The purpose of this act is to create an environment in which the people of Florida and its visitors will be reminded of the accomplishments made by our military veterans in past conflicts and the continuing sacrifices made by those veterans and their families to protect the freedoms we enjoy today.

Section 3. The Department of Transportation is authorized to enter into contract with any group or organization for the installation and maintenance of monuments and memorials honoring our military veterans at highway rest areas around the state pursuant to the provisions of this section.

- (1) Proposals for contracts under this act must be approved by a committee composed of the secretary of the Department of Transportation or the secretary's designee, the executive director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs or the executive director's designee, and three members of the Florida Commission on Veterans' Affairs appointed by the chair of the commission. Appointed members of the committee shall be appointed for terms of not longer than 2 years and may be reappointed to the committee. All appointed members' terms shall expire on January 31 of each even-numbered year.
- (2) Installations may consist of monuments, memorials, plaques, markers, or various retired military equipment and must honor the accomplishments of military veterans and the sacrifices made by them and their families.

(3) The group or organization making the proposal shall be responsible for all costs of the monument and its installation.

(4) The group or organization making the proposal shall be responsible for the cost of maintenance of the monument. The cost of maintenance shall be secured by sufficient funds provided annually by the group or organization making the proposal deposited into a maintenance account held by the Department of Transportation. In addition, the group or organization making the proposal shall provide a 10-year bond securing the cost of removal of the monument, and any modifications made to the site as part of the placement of the monument, for use should the group or organization making the proposal fail to provide sufficient funds for maintenance for a period of 2 consecutive years. Prior to expiration, the bond shall be renewed for another 10-year period if the memorial is to remain in place.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
