82	(3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), any use,
83	building, or structure that is legally in existence at the time
84	that the area described in section 1 becomes a part of the
85	municipality shall not be made a prohibited use by the
86	municipality, on the property of said use, for as long as the
87	use shall continue, and said use shall not be voluntarily
88	abandoned.
89	Section 4. Subsequent to the effective date of this act,
90	no change in land use designation or zoning shall be effective
91	within the limits of the lands subject to annexation herein
