An act relating to Broward County; providing for extending the corporate limits of the City of Pompano Beach; providing for annexation of specified unincorporated areas; providing for an interlocal agreement; providing for continuation of certain Broward County regulations; providing for the transfer of Broward County roads and rights-of-way; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. <u>Effective September 15, 2004, the following</u> described lands shall be annexed into and become a part of the City of Pompano Beach:

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That portion of Sections 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26, Township 48 South, Range 42 East, Broward County, Florida, described as follows:

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24 25 BEGINNING at the intersection of the Easterly right-26 of-way line of the Florida East Coast Railway as 27 described in Ordinance No. 80-38 of the City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach with the South 28 29 right-of-way line of N.E. 24 Street (Copans Road), as 30 described in said Ordinance No. 80-38; 31 Thence Northwesterly and Westerly along said South 32 33 right-of-way line and along the municipal boundary of 34 the City of Pompano Beach, as described in said 35 Ordinance No. 80-38, through said Section 25 and into 36 said Section 26, to the East line of the West half of 37 said Section 26; 38 39 Thence Northerly along said East line and along the 40 municipal boundary of the City of Pompano Beach, as 41 described in Chapter 69-1513, Laws of Florida, to the 42 North line of the West One-Half (W ½) of said Section 43 26; 44 45 Thence Westerly along said North line, along the South 46 line of the Southeast One-Quarter (SE 1/4) of said 47 Section 22 and along said municipal boundary, to the 48 Easterly right-of-way line of the Seaboard Coastline 49 Railroad; 50

135 Beach, as described in Chapter 2000-458, Laws of 136 Florida; 137 138 Thence Northeasterly along said municipal boundary and 139 along said Easterly right-of-way line to the 140 centerline of N.W. 36 Street (Sample Road); 141 142 Thence Easterly along said centerline to the Easterly 143 right-of-way line of the Florida East Coast Railway, 144 being a point on the municipal boundary of the City of 145 Pompano Beach, as described in Chapter 2000-476, Laws 146 of Florida; 147 148 Thence Southwesterly along said Easterly right-of-way line and along said municipal boundary to the POINT OF 149 150 BEGINNING. 151 152 Section 2. An interlocal agreement shall be developed 153 between the governing bodies of Broward County and the City of 154 Pompano Beach and executed prior to the effective date of the 155 annexation as provided for in section 1. The agreement shall 156 include a financially feasible plan for transitioning county services, buildings, infrastructure, waterways, and employees. 157 158 Section 3. Upon annexation into the municipality, the 159 following shall govern the areas described in section 1: 160 The present land use designations and zoning districts 161 provided for under the Broward County Comprehensive Plan and 162 Code of Ordinances of Broward County shall remain the law

governing the area described in section 1, notwithstanding the fact that the area described in section 1 is now a part of a municipality.

- (2) Any change of zoning districts or land use designations may only be accomplished by enactment of the vote of the majority of the full governing body of the municipality plus one.
- (3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), any use, building, or structure that is legally in existence at the time that the area described in section 1 becomes a part of the municipality, said use shall not be made a prohibited use by the municipality, on the property of said use, for as long as the use shall continue and not be voluntarily abandoned.

Section 4. Subsequent to the effective date of this act, no change in land use designation or zoning shall be effective within the limits of the lands subject to annexation herein until the area described in section 1 has been annexed into the municipality; and no annexation within the area described in section 1 by any municipality shall occur during the time period between the effective date of this act and the effective date of the annexation.

Section 5. Subsequent to the effective date of the annexation, any resident in the area to be annexed into the City of Pompano Beach by this act shall be deemed to have met any residency requirements for candidacy for any municipal office.

Section 6. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to affect or abrogate the rights of parties to any contracts, whether the same be between Broward County and a third party or

between nongovernmental entities, which contracts are in effect prior to the effective date of the annexation.

System, and the public roads on the Broward County Road

System, and the public rights-of-way associated therewith, lying within the limits of the lands subject to annexation herein, as described in section 1, are transferred from Broward County jurisdiction to the jurisdiction of the City of Pompano Beach.

All rights, title, interests, and responsibilities for such transferred roads, including, but not limited to, the ownership, operation, maintenance, planning, design, and construction of said roads and the rights-of-way associated therewith shall transfer from Broward County jurisdiction and ownership to the jurisdiction and ownership of the City of Pompano Beach upon the effective date of the annexation.

Section 8. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
