An act relating to legal holidays; amending s.
683.01, F.S.; deleting Confederate Memorial Day
and the birthday of Jefferson Davis as legal
holidays in this state; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 683.01, Florida Statutes, is
amended to read:

683.01 Legal holidays.--

(1) The legal holidays, which are also public
holidays, are the following:

- (a) Sunday, the first day of each week.
- (b) New Year's Day, January 1.
- (c) Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr., January 15.
- (d) Birthday of Robert E. Lee, January 19.
- (e) Lincoln's Birthday, February 12.
- (f) Susan B. Anthony's Birthday, February 15.
- (g) Washington's Birthday, the third Monday in
February.
- (h) Good Friday.
- (i) Pascua Florida Day, April 2.
- ~~(j) Confederate Memorial Day, April 26.~~
- (j)~~(k)~~ Memorial Day, the last Monday in May.
- ~~(l) Birthday of Jefferson Davis, June 3.~~
- (k)~~(m)~~ Flag Day, June 14.
- (l)~~(n)~~ Independence Day, July 4.
- (m)~~(o)~~ Labor Day, the first Monday in September.
