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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to nurse registries; repealing
s. 400.506(10)(c), F.S.; deleting provisions
requiring that a registered nurse periodically
visit the home of each patient who is attended
by a certified nursing assistant or home health
aide referred by a nurse registry, in order to
assess the patient's medical condition and the
quality of care that is being provided to the
patient, and deleting provisions requiring
specified reports and recordkeeping relating to
such assessments; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (10) of section
400.506, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.

SENATE SUMMARY

Deletes provisions requiring that a registered nurse
periodically visit the home of each patient who is
attended by a certified nursing assistant or home health
aide referred by a nurse registry, in order to assess the
patient's medical condition and the quality of care that
is being provided to the patient, and deletes provisions
requiring specified reports and recordkeeping relating to
such assessments.
