Section 1. The Legislature shall conduct an interim study of the issues surrounding antiquated subdivisions, and suggest statutory and non-statutory mechanisms and incentives to promote the redevelopment of antiquated subdivisions in a manner designed to meet current planning and environmental standards, and promote the marketability of such redesigned communities.

Any proposals must recognize and maintain the property rights of all property owners to provide certainty to property owners regarding how property rights will be maintained while redevelopment is encouraged and promoted. Antiquated subdivisions, for the purposes of this study, shall be defined as residential subdivisions created prior to 1980 of more than

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500 lots, in which little actual residential development has occurred and the vast majority of the property is vacant and in no productive use.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
