- 3. Proof of identity satisfactory to the department. 3 Such proof must include one of the following documents issued to the applicant:
- 5 a. A driver's license record or identification card record from another jurisdiction that required the applicant 6 to submit a document for identification which is substantially 7 similar to a document required under sub-subparagraph b., 8 9 sub-subparagraph c., sub-subparagraph d., sub-subparagraph e., or sub-subparagraph f., or sub-subparagraph q.; 10
 - b. A certified copy of a United States birth certificate;
 - c. A valid United States passport;
- d. A naturalization certificate issued by the United 15 States Department of Justice;
 - e.d. An alien registration receipt card (green card);
- 17 f.e. An employment authorization card issued by the United States Department of Justice; or 18
- 19 q.f. Proof of nonimmigrant classification provided by the United States Department of Justice, for an original 20 identification card. In order to prove such nonimmigrant 2.1 classification, applicants may produce but are not limited to 22 23 the following documents:
 - (I) A notice of hearing from an immigration court scheduling a hearing on any proceeding.
 - (II) A notice from the Board of Immigration Appeals acknowledging pendency of an appeal.
- (III) Notice of the approval of an application for 28 adjustment of status issued by the United States Immigration 29 30 and Naturalization Service.
- 31 (IV) Any official documentation confirming the filing

of a petition for asylum status or any other relief issued by the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service.

- (V) Notice of action transferring any pending matter from another jurisdiction to Florida, issued by the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service.
- (VI) Order of an immigration judge or immigration officer granting any relief that authorizes the alien to live and work in the United States including, but not limited to asylum.

Presentation of any of the foregoing documents described in sub-subparagraph f. or sub-subparagraph q. entitles shall entitle the applicant to an identification card a driver's license or temporary permit for a period not to exceed the expiration date of the document presented or 2 years, whichever first occurs.

- (b) An application for an identification card must be signed and verified by the applicant in a format designated by the department before a person authorized to administer oaths. The fee for an identification card is \$3, including payment for the color photograph or digital image of the applicant.
- (c) Each such applicant may include fingerprints and any other unique biometric means of identity.
- (2)(a) Every identification card shall expire, unless canceled earlier, on the sixth fourth birthday of the applicant following the date of original issue. However, if an individual is 60 years of age or older, and has an identification card issued under this section, the card shall not expire unless done so by cancellation by the department or by the death of the cardholder. Renewal of any identification 31 | card shall be made for a term which shall expire on the sixth

fourth birthday of the applicant following expiration of the identification card renewed, unless surrendered earlier. Any 3 application for renewal received later than 90 days after expiration of the identification card shall be considered the 4 5 same as an application for an original identification card. The renewal fee for an identification card shall be \$10, of 6 which \$4 shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund and \$6 into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund. The 8 department shall, at the end of 64 years and 6 months after 9 the issuance or renewal of an identification card, destroy any 10 11 record of the card if it has expired and has not been renewed, unless the cardholder is 60 years of age or older. 12 13

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, if an applicant establishes his or her identity for an identification card using a document authorized under sub-subparagraph(1)(a)3.e.(a)3.d., the identification card shall expire on the sixth fourth birthday of the applicant following the date of original issue or upon first renewal or duplicate issued after implementation of this section. After an initial showing of such documentation, he or she is exempted from having to renew or obtain a duplicate in person.
