Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 3, between lines 12 and 13,

insert:

Section 3. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall, in cooperation with representatives of the local tax collectors and with Prison Rehabilitative Industries and Diversified Enterprises, Inc., at Union Correctional Facility, study the operational and economic feasibility of direct-to-customer delivery of specialty license plates. The study shall include, but not be limited to, an analysis of the potential operational and economic impact of various manufacturing, inventory control, and product distribution technologies on the speciality license plate program. The department shall report its findings to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later than December 31, 2004.
